

## CREDIT ACCEPTANCE FOR TRANSFERRING STUDENTS

535

### PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

Students transferring from public schools outside this district will receive credit toward high school graduation for those classes successfully completed at the previous public school.

### NONPUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

Students transferring from nonpublic schools, including parochial and home study, will receive credit toward high school graduation for courses successfully completed at the non-public school as follows:

1. If the nonpublic school is accredited by the Idaho State Board of Education, other state accrediting agency, or other regional accreditation agency (Northwest Accrediting Association), the student will receive credit as awarded by the nonpublic school for all non-secular courses.
2. Students transferring from parochial schools will, in no case, receive more than .5 credits per semester credit awarded by the parochial school for courses in Old Testament/Bible Literature and New Testament/Bible History.
