

Student Fund Raising Activities

The Board recognizes that the solicitations of funds (fundraising) by students and staff may be desired to augment student programs or activities. The Board limits funds solicitation and collection of money by students and staff for student use, including the collection of money by students in exchange for tickets, papers, magazine subscriptions, or for any other goods or services for the benefit of an approved school organization or activity. Fund raised funds must be utilized only for purposes sanctioned by the District's general guidelines of student use of funds. For instance, fund raised funds cannot be used for any purpose which does not fall within the District parameters of appropriate expenditures. Solicitation of funds for student use may be permitted by the Board of Trustees, providing that the instructional program is not adversely affected. Solicitation of businesses is strongly discouraged.

Approval of the scheduled fundraiser by the Board or Board Designee must be obtained prior to public advertisement of the intent to fund raise. Application of intent to fund raise shall be made on regular forms secured from one of the building principals or at the office of the Superintendent.

Applications shall be acted upon by the Board of Trustees, or Board Designee, who may require any information of applicants, may reject any application and may cancel any permit previously issued.

Any persons soliciting money, services, goods, or donations via fundraising must carry a copy of the District approval form with the District's stamp of approval and signature of the Board Representative.
